An Introduction

Osmani Trust is a youth and community organisation currently operating in the London Borough of Tower Hamlets and Newham. The organisation delivers a host of services for young people and the community. These can be generally grouped into the following themes: crime prevention; gang mediation; community safety, health and sports; education, training and employment and generic youth club and holiday provisions. The aims of the organisation are as follows:

- Establish and advance the social, physical and spiritual education of young people and their families, particularly those residing in disadvantaged urban communities.
- Provide facilities for their recreation and other leisure time occupation with the objective of improving quality of life.
- Fill gaps in sports and health provisions for deprived members of the community.
- Work in partnership with other community organisations to help socially excluded members of the community fulfil their potential and progress in life.

History

Osmani Trust was established formally in 2009 after a merge of two local youth organisations, Elite Youth and the Brick Lane Youth Development Association (BLYDA). The Trust is well known in the area and has been providing local youth services and support to young people across the Banglatown and Spitalfields area for over 3 decades.

Osmani Trust is considered to be one of the leading 3rd sector youth providers in the Tower Hamlets area. The organisation has evolved organically following the merge of Elite Youth and BLYDA. The organisation is financially sustainable from an operational point of view, and has a great deal of support from the local Tower Hamlets Council.

The Trustees are well respected community figures and their longstanding relationship and management of the Trust (and the previous organisations) has ensured continuity. This continuity has given the local community, financial supporters of the Trust, political figures and key statutory decision-makers confidence in their ability to deliver quality provision that make lasting impact on the ground.



Expressions of Interest

Contract Value: OPEN

Osmani Trust is seeking expressions of interest from prospective suppliers for the development of an urban roof garden. The requirement is to design, supply and fit one roof garden in the Osmani Centre.

An 'expression of interest' should include the following information:

- A. Main Contact Details
- B. Contact Details of Your Organisation
- C. Relevant Qualifications & Experience (expertise of staff and details of relevant recent work)

Expressions of Interest must be emailed no later than 12.00 pm on Monday 30th January 2012

Companies expressing an interest will then be invited to bid for the works via an Invitation To Tender.

Contract Award Criteria

The contract, if awarded, will be awarded to the bidder submitting the 'most economically advantageous tender'.

Criteria relevant to the assessment (in no particular order of priority) are:

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| 1. Technical Capability | 40% |
| 2. Resource Capability | 10% |
| 3. Costs and Commercial Considerations | 30% |
| 4. Timescale for delivery | 15% |
| 5. Innovation Demonstrated | 5% |

As part of the evaluation process, Bidder's will be invited to demonstrations/ presentations. The audience will include the tender evaluation panel and will form part of the final evaluation score.

Osmani Trust does not undertake to invite all applicants or bind itself to accept the lowest or any tender. The Trust will not be liable for any costs incurred in tendering for this contract.



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
